- Complying with all host country health and safety laws as a minimum.
- Implementing best practice health and safety management systems and standards aligned with ISO 45001:2018 and other internationally accepted standards and conventions.
- The identification, and management of health and safety risks to As Low As Reasonably Practicable.
- Establishing measurable objectives and targets that indicate the effectiveness of the health and safety management system.
- Providing all necessary training, education, equipment, resources and information to support a healthy and safe work environment.
- Promoting open communication and consultation on health and safety matters to encourage personal involvement and
 positive attitudes towards health and safety.
- Supporting the rehabilitation and reintegration of employees following workplace stress, illness or injury.
- Effectively developed, tested and maintained emergency response capabilities.
- Continuously monitoring, reviewing and improving our health and safety management systems and performance.

All directors, employees, contractors, and visitors are required to:

- Report all hazards, incidents and injuries to Company Management, and implement and support effective actions.
- Comply with all Company policies, standards and procedures.
- · Always present in a fit condition to undertake their duties.
- Observe and support safe behaviours including intervening where unsafe acts, behaviours or circumstances occur.
